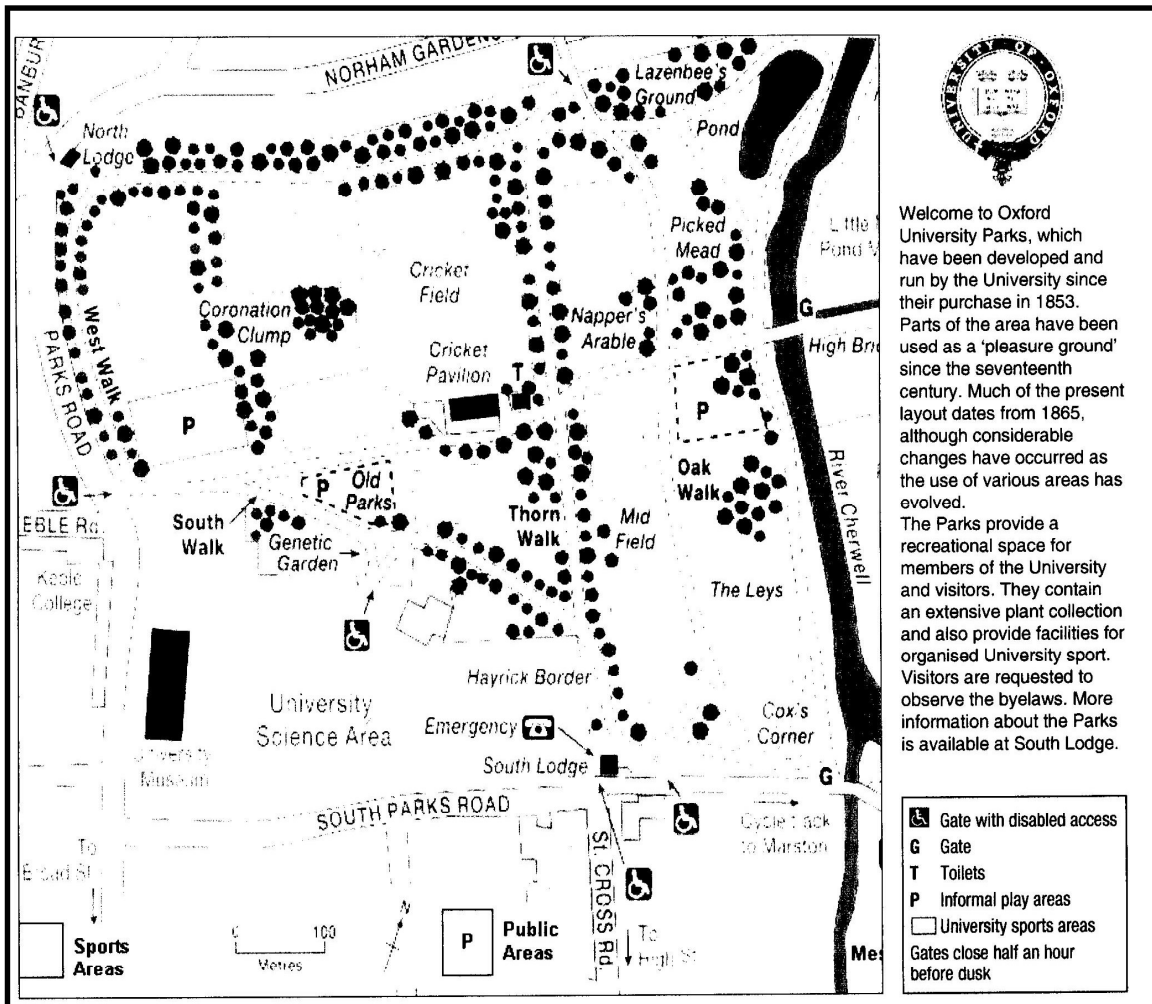

The Rotary Oxford 2011 Charity Fun Run & Walk for the Less Able Directions



Welcome to Oxford University Parks, which have been developed and run by the University since their purchase in 1853. Parts of the area have been used as a 'pleasure ground' since the seventeenth century. Much of the present layout dates from 1865, although considerable changes have occurred as the use of various areas has evolved. The Parks provide a recreational space for members of the University and visitors. They contain an extensive plant collection and also provide facilities for organised University sport. Visitors are requested to observe the byelaws. More information about the Parks is available at South Lodge.

Entry to the University Parks is by the North Lodge Gate (by the traffic lights off the Banbury Road). Car Parking is available (Pay & Display in some areas) in Norham Gardens adjacent to the North Lodge Gate. Runners will be given their Chest Number Cards on arrival at the Check-In Desk on the day.
